- A Diplomatic Reception strictly on invitation
- A Gala Evening for the Cameroonian Diaspora on 15 March 2014 from 6 pm to 12 pm at the Kensington Town Hall

- A Ecumenical Service at a date to be announced

The Cameroonian Community is cordially invited to the Gala Evening and the Ecumenical Service. The Gala evening will only be opened to people over the age of 20.

Due to the limited capacity of the Great Hall of the Kensington Town Hall, Cameroonians are recommended to come early as the seating arrangement will be strictly on a first come, first served basis. There will be full security and crowd control monitoring in place (which may include checking Cameroonian identification), so late comers may be politely asked to wait outside until there is a place for them inside the Hall.
