Diaspora Forum: Yaoundé, June 2017

The present public notice is to give an update to the Cameroonian Community in the United Kingdom and the Scandinavian Countries on the Diaspora Forum to be organised in Cameroon.

First of all, the High Commission would like to inform the public that due to the very crowded national agenda at this end of the year, the planned Diaspora Forum scheduled for December 2016 has been postponed. The new proposed date is from **28 to 29 June 2017**.

Cameroonians are informed that those who want to submit their business proposals for the Forum should do so by **28 February 2017** either directly to the Ministry of External Relations in Yaounde or through the High Commission in London.

The theme of the Forum is: **Cameroon and its Diaspora: "Striving together for the Nation's Development"**.

They are encouraged to fill and return the skills and competences survey (or their profile), send project proposals and scientific contributions on any topic relevant to the Forum.

Finally, they are encouraged to participate in the various Task Forces set up to brainstorm and prepare projects for the Forum.
