## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Cameroonian community in the United Kingdom is hereby informed that the second phase of the programme to recruit **549 PhD/Doctorate** degree holders into the teaching corps of Cameroon's Public Universities has been launched. Interested persons who must not be older than **45 years on October 1, 2020** can deposit their applications directly in the university of their choice. Alternatively, they may also deposit them at the Cameroon High Commission in London on or before **July 30, 2020**. Applicants for the position of Assistant Lecturer are expected to undergo a selection interview organised by the university to which they have applied. Details of the specialties advertised can be obtained from the universities.

Application files must comprise the following:

- A stamped application not more than three (03) months old addressed to the Rector or Vice-Chancellor of the university of your choice;
- A certified true copy of birth certificate not more than three (03) months old;
- A signed detailed curriculum vitae;
- Certified true copies of all academic certificates obtained from GCE A/L or baccalaureate;
- A copy of the doctorate or PhD thesis;

- Copies of published articles or contributions to publications or eventual publications;
- A medical certificate of fitness not more than three (03) months old signed by a doctor working in a government health institution in Cameroon;
- Four (04) coloured passport size photos (4x4);
- A coloured photocopy of a Cameroonian valid National identity card;
- For candidates already teaching in other universities and seeking recruitment as senior Lecturer, Associate Professor or Professor, a valid testimonial signed by a competent officer of the university of origin must be submitted with the application;
- A certificate of non-conviction not more than three (03) months old (*Une extrait du bulletin no. 3 du casier judiciaire*);
- A certificate of nationality and/or photocopy of passport or residence permit certified by the Cameroonian consular services, for candidates residing in the diaspora;
- An attestation of active service signed by the competent authorities for candidates wishing to change from their corps to Higher Education;
- An authorisation from your minister or head of administration for candidates wishing to change their professional corps;
- A copy of the National Incapacitation certificate for handicapped persons;
- A declaration on honour regarding:
  - o The authenticity of all documents submitted
  - o Availability to work for candidates resident abroad
  - o Inexistence of any situation that may lead to a candidate receiving two salaries.
