



PUBLIC NOTICE

(Registration of Voters)

The Cameroonian Diaspora in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Denmark, Finland, Norway, Sweden and Iceland are hereby informed that the voters' registration process opened since 01 January 2024 as stipulated by law. However, the process experienced some disruptions due to the malfunction of biometric Kits (registration machines).

ELECAM is sending out a team of technicians in the coming week to repair and/or replace faulty biometric kits for the registration of voters in Cameroon Diplomatic Missions and Consular Posts, including the High Commission for Cameroon in London. The resolution of this problem will make it possible to relaunch the revision and registration operations on the voters' roll soon. A public announcement will be made accordingly.

Furthermore, representatives of political parties in the UK are urgently requested to register at the High Commission, latest 07 May 2024, for purposes of official accreditation and updating the list of members of the commission to revise the electoral roll. They must present documents officially designating them as representatives.

The High Commission urges compatriots in UK and the Scandinavian countries to be patient and commends them for their understanding and sense of citizenship.
